# VETERANS RIDE LTD FOR FREE ON VETERANS DAY

Veterans of the United States Armed Forces can ride for free on LTD buses on **Friday, November 10 and Veterans Day, Saturday, November 11, 2023.** Veterans who tell the bus operator that they served in the United States Armed Forces will ride for free on both days. Military Veterans aged 65 and over are always eligible

to ride LTD buses for free with an Honored Rider pass.



Anyone 65 years and older can enroll in the <u>Honored Rider</u> pass program at the Customer Service Centers at Eugene and Springfield Stations. Veterans who receive 50% or higher disability benefits are also eligible for half-price bus fares aboard LTD buses. Visit a Customer Service Center for more information. 


# **STUFF THE BUS TO HELP LOCAL FAMILIES**
