WEST EUGENE EMX CONSTRUCTION IMPACTS

Paratransit Service May be Available to Riders Impacted by Construction

West Eugene EmX road and sidewalk construction is nearly done on West 6th Avenue. Road excavation is currently under way on Garfield Street between West 7th and 11th Avenues, and on West 11 Avenue, west of Bertelsen Road.

If EmX construction temporarily closes a bus stop or sidewalks near a stop, riders with disabilities who use that stop may be eligible to use RideSource during construction impacts. If you experience issues accessing your destination due to construction, please call LTD's Accessible Services Program at 541-682-7432.

May 14 - 20

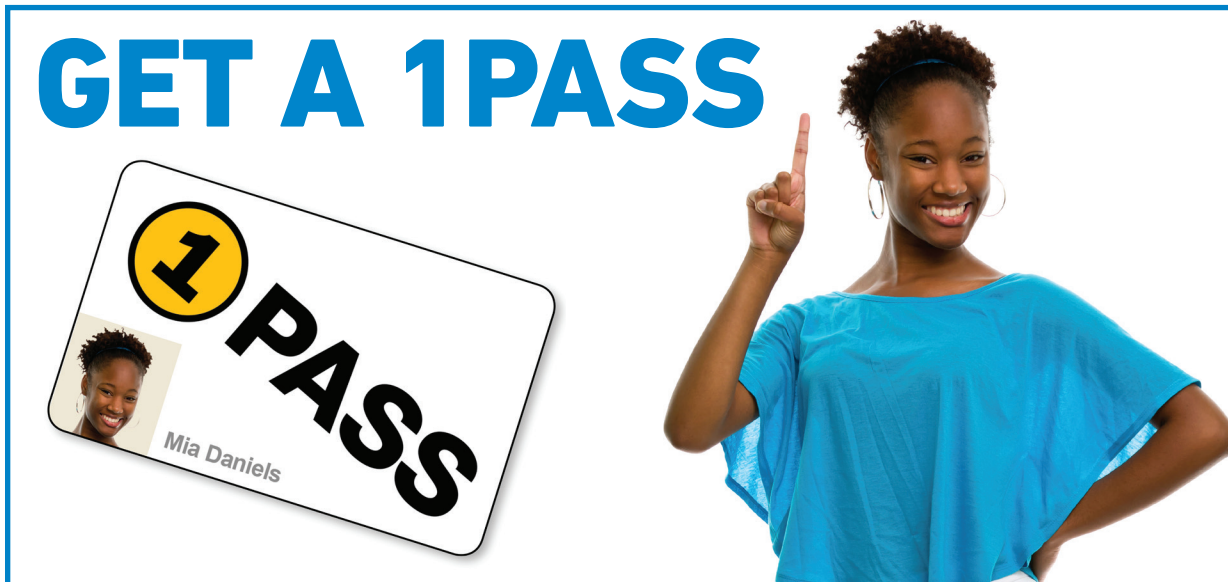
