As the school year comes to an end, Lane Transit District wants to remind students to get their free Student Transit Pass before summer break. All K-12 students in public, private, charter, and home schools across Lane County are eligible for the Student Transit Pass program. Students and parents can visit their school's office to get an electronic tap card or information about how to use the Umo Mobility app to redeem a Student Transit Pass. Students must get their bus pass before the last day of school to continue riding the bus for free all summer long.

If you didn't get your student's pass before summer break, LTD will issue limited quantities of passes at those events. 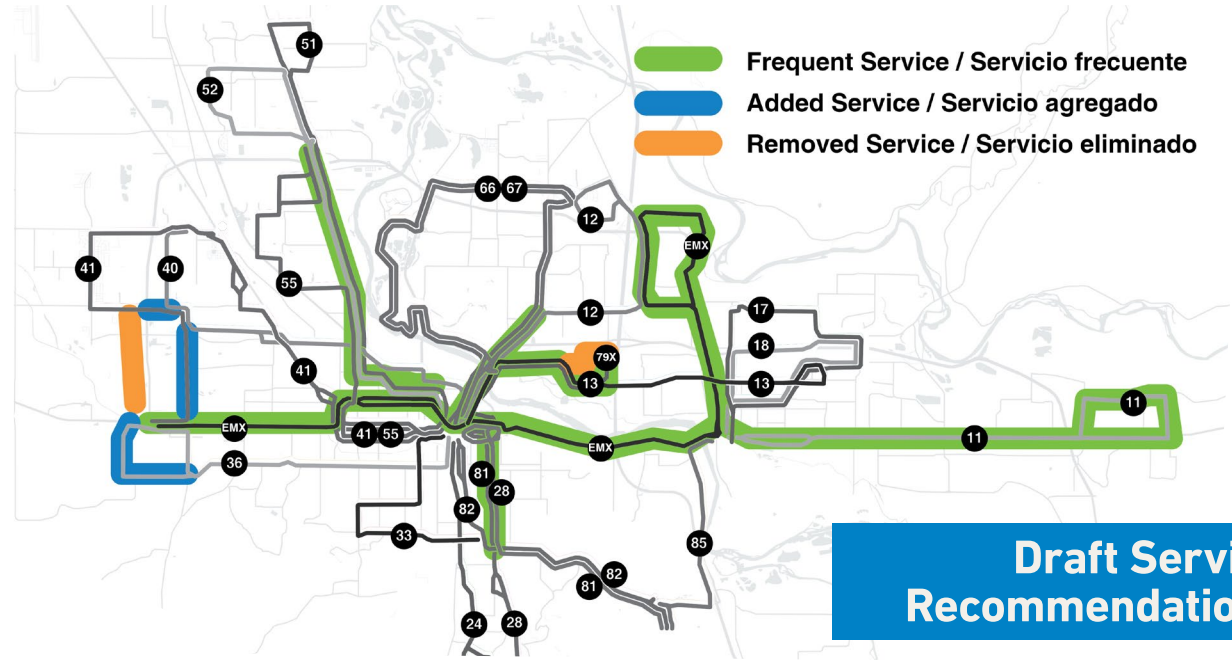


THERE'S A LOT TO SEE ON LTD
