LTD IS YOUR STRESS-FREE RIDE TO THE GAME

The Ducks are back at Autzen Stadium on October 4, 12, and 26! Duck fans can avoid traffic and parking hassles by taking the bus to the game. Riding the bus to Autzen Stadium is as easy as 1, 2, 3!

- **1. Purchase fare** in the <u>Umo app</u> or at EmX ticket vending machines.
- 2. Ride EmX to Agate Station.
- **3. Travel** across the footbridge to Autzen Stadium.

For even more travel options, fans can leave their vehicle at one of LTD's 21 free Park & Ride locations, board their neighborhood

bus to Eugene or Springfield Stations, then transfer to EmX toward Agate Station.

Renting a **PeaceHealth Rides** bike from our partners at Cascadia Mobility is a great option, too!

On days with University of Oregon home football games, detours are in effect on Routes 12, 13, 28, 66, 67, 79X, and 96.

Depending on game day traffic, other bus routes may be impacted.

EXPERIENCE INCREASED INDEPENDENCE & SECURITY

With LTD's Automatic ADA Securement System

LTD is testing an automatic wheelchair securement system that allows many riders to secure their mobility devices quickly and independently with the push of a button. Bus operators are also trained to provide assistance with securement whenever needed. The new system is installed on two 40-foot buses, which will be circulated throughout LTD's neighborhood routes. If space is available, riders may choose to use the manual securement system instead of the automatic wheelchair securement system.

WELCOME BACK TO CAMPUS, DUCKS & TITANS!

It's easy for UO students and employees, Lane Community College students, and Pacific University students to get a free LTD bus pass. Visit the <u>UO</u>

Transportation Services website or the <u>LCC Bus Pass</u> webpage for instructions on how to get started with <u>LTD's e-fare system called Umo</u>. Bus passes are valid on EmX and all neighborhood bus routes. When you board the EmX, 79X, or any neighborhood bus route, remember to have your bus pass ready to scan on the Umo app or your tap card. See detailed instructions on how to request and redeem a benefit code to get your bus pass on your school's website.

79X service now operates from 7:20 a.m. to 6:20 p.m. The evening service from 6:30 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. that was funded by the Associated Students of the University of Oregon will no longer operate.

REMINDER: FARE REQUIRED ON EMX BUSES

All riders must have valid fare to ride EmX buses. Please plan to purchase bus fare at a ticket vending machine on EmX platforms, in the Umo app, or at UmoPass.com **before you board**. Be prepared to show your fare to a public safety officer when riding EmX buses.


